NICOLE H reserved just to the outside of the early pace skirmish, advanced to make a bid departing the half mile pole, effortlessly swept past both early pace combatants to take charge by midpoint on the turn, opened up a sizeable advantage by the head of the stretch then drew off with authority, a handy winner. DEVILS HUMOR sparred with SOUMA down the backstretch from the inside, had no answer when the top one zoomed by on the turn, but came back on willingly to secure the place. VERSE CHOIR bumped between rivals shortly after the break, was coaxed along to keep pace, came under stronger pressure nearing the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the one during the stretch, getting outkicked for place honors as well. VICTORIA LYNN bumped lightly after the start, swung three wide into the lane and came home with a mild rally to improve position. SOUMA bumped after the break, vied for the lead from the two path and faltered after going three furlongs. LEXIE G. was taken in hand after breaking a bit at the start, was put to a long drive, but had no serious offering. SPINA bumped with VERSE CHOIR soon after the start, raced four wide around the turn, and had no kick. RED BARCHETTA took the inside route, failed to gain ground appreciably despite being put to encouragement leaving the half mile pole, swung off the rail turning for home and tired.
