Footnotes

EXTRAEXTRAORDINARY reserved during the initial stages, left the backstretch three wide, was in the four path by midpoint on the far turn, entered the stretch and took off in earnest after the front runners, closed in steadily throughout the stretch run, getting the head down in time to prevail. HEADINGTOTHACITY left well and quickly secured a forward position, was in hand showing the way from the inside, feeling some pressure from LOGICAL ORDER all the while, came under heavier pressure nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was let out a notch in response and put to stronger handling soon

afterwards, edged away during the run through the furlong grounds, was put to the test a second time in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, dug in gamely, but had to settle for the place. PERFECT JOISKI sat within range, was under a drive spinning three wide into the stretch, narrowed the gap leaving the furlong marker, bid between rivals for the last sixteenth, came up short. COSMIC KING three wide around the opening bend, raced off the inside around the subsequent one as well, altered course for better racing room in upper stretch and came home willingly. MARINE OFFICER saved ground, was given a shake of the reins prior to angling outward and splitting rivals at the five-sixteenths pole, appeared a threat near the inside with an eighth to go, soon flattened out. LAUNCH N RELAUNCH underwent a three to four wide journey and lacked the necessary stretch response. BINKS FOREST raced three wide around both turns, issued a challenge for the lead leaving the the three-eighths pole, nearly made it there but fell short, kept up the pursuit until midstretch before backing away. STORM GALILEO between rivals in the initial going, steadied while rank about midway down the backstretch, was placed more towards the middle shortly afterwards, unleashed a bold four wide sweep on the far turn, held his ground willingly, before being taken hold of leaving the sixteenth pole, by now starting to weaken. NOAH'S HARVEST three wide on the first turn, was through after going six furlongs. AHGOGO was no factor. LOGICAL ORDER accompanied the pacesetter from the two path for almost six furlongs, folded. MEGALITHIC bobbed at the start, took the inside route, was put to a prolonged drive, faded.
