Footnotes

BEST ACTOR patiently pursued the front runners from the three path, had just poked a head in front when finally asked for some run just past the three-sixteenths pole, dueled with CINDER CONE for the next furlong, before edging away under good handling. CINDER CONE prompted the pacesetter from the outside, moved when ready to take over coming to the five-sixteenths pole, went by to grab the front, and was let out a notch in response to the eventual winner's upcoming challenge, turned for home and was put to stronger handling, behind by a sliver soon afterwards, battled back hard to re gain the advantage before successfully shaken off in the final sixteenth. MAD FOR SMARTY brushed at the start, sat reserved from just off the inside, made a mild run to loom a brief threat at the furlong marker, failed to keep pace with the top twosome, but held well to secure the show. NEVER RIGHT JOEY four wide at the half mile pole, came home willingly en route for the final major check. PRESUMPTIVE made light contact with MAD FOR SMARTY after bobbling at the break, raced along the outside, was placed six wide by the three-sixteenths pole, taking two stages to get there, completed the maneuver and displayed a mild kick to improve position. HIGH STAKES PLAYER saved ground to no avail. TROPONIN three wide on the turn, folded. SUMMER SHARE placed on the overland route for the run around the bend, was outrun. ALMIGHTY SILVER bobbed at the break, left the backstretch from the three path and offered little. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC was taken gradually towards the inside making his way to the half mile pole, argued for command from the rail, was under a full drive by midway on the turn, yielded, then retreated.
