Footnotes

CATALONIA broke on top and easily established control, sat entrenched in the two path sailing along on an open lead, with the rider applying a firm grip on the reins, scampered away during the later stages of the run around the bend, waited until turning for home before asked for a response, extended the advantage, got geared down during the final sixteenth yet held a healthy margin to the end. GET ER UP guided over to the rail coming to the half mile pole, proved no match for the winner. PRINCESS REYANA raced two to three wide on the turn, was under a drive attempting to rally from between opponents approaching the quarter pole, wasn't up to the task at hand and had to settle for the show award. TATOO ME briefly took the inside route on the turn, was switched over to the outside at the midway point, fanned six wide into upper stretch, got straightened away and mustered up a mild closing response to grab the last major check. DEAR ELIZABETH saved ground and failed to menace. STILL WAITING gave it a tepid effort chasing the winner from the outside for a half and tired. BLACK AND WHITE got away three lengths behind the penultimate breaker after making solid contact with the right side of the starting gate, departed the backstretch from the four path, folded. THIS SATURDAY off the inside, was steadied and tipped out a couple of paths to steer by with plenty of

room to spare the spill in upper stretch. AT THE PALACE along the backstretch, chose a wider path as the way to go around the turn, drifted seven wide into the stretch and had no offering to render. BAYSHORE BLAZE three wide, loosely stalked the top one for less than a half before backing away. SHE'S GOSPHEL raced along the outside, had just settled into upper stretch when forced to take up after the incident in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, wasn't striding properly then was eased shortly afterwards. THIRTY MINUTES three wide on the turn, broke down in upper stretch and was humanely put down. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident in upper stretch before the result was declared official.
