ASSOCIATE came in slightly at the start, sparred from the two path on nearly even terms with the third place finisher for the opening half, edged away from that opponent once set down, was kept busy to the end. ARCH TRAVELER saved ground until upper stretch, out finished BELLAMY BREW to be along for the place. BELLAMY BREW dueled with the winner while taking the inside route, arrived at the quarter pole under much stronger handling than the chief nemesis, got shaken off during the run through the furlong grounds, eventually weakening into the show slot. GOOD MORNING DIVA was put to a prolonged drive, angled outward from the three-eighths pole until three wide by the head of the stretch, proved no match for any of the front runners. BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT under encouragement coming three wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. YA GOTTA HAVE SOUL saved ground and was outrun. INFLATION TARGET three to four wide on the turn and always the widest of all, felt the whip before making it halfway around the bend, folded.
