BELLE GALLANTEY followed SO BLESSED over to the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, was back to the outside before reaching the end of the bend, cut into the gap readily, turned for home already under solid encouragement, altered course to the outside coming to the three-sixteenths marker, hitched up to the front runners and contested for the lead from that station to the sixteenth pole, being the outermost of the three combatants, wrested away the advantage for good and kicked away, kept busy to the end. INSOLVENT emerged from a tight pack after the start with the lead, tucked along the rail and sprinted off from the competition, rider applying a snug grip on the reins, had all but squandered the advantage by the quarter pole, got engaged in a three way tussle once the winner made her presence in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, fell back by a sliver at the eighth pole, failed to keep up with the winner when that opponent took over, staged a mild comeback for place honors. SO BLESSED bumped lightly with WITH DIAMONDS at the start, was guided over to the rail a few strides before reaching the half mile pole, closed in with good energy proceeding around the turn, tipped into the two path prior to the quarter pole, entered the stretch on even terms with the second place finisher and was let out, battled between rivals from upper stretch to work her way to lead by a slim margin with an eighth to go, lost it to the winner then got outfinished in the late stages for place honors as well. ORIGINAL KITTEN lost her footing at the break, raced from the two path on the turn, was under a full drive heading for the top of the lane, had no gain. WITH DIAMONDS made light contact with SO BLESSED right after the start, undertook a tepid chase from the two path and folded.
