COOL UNDER FIRE brushed at the start, moved up to secure a forward position anyway, vied for command as the innermost of three, was taken hold and eased back during the later stages of the run around the bend, got cued up and angled three wide for the start of the drive home, fought outside the winner for command and gamely got the job done. LONG RIVER got clipped shortly after the start, the end result of a crowding incident initiated by ALL THAT, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, ranged up and challenged in earnest heading for the top of the lane, gained a sliver of a lead, drifted out a bit in the final sixteenth while being engaged by the winner, yielded and had to settle for the place. STREET THUG brushed at the start, vied for command from between rivals for a good portion of the run around the bend, remained a prominent factor before weakening in the final furlong. INDY'S ILLUSION the lone member of the field totally unscathed at the break, saved ground for nearly three-quarters, had already been put to the whip by the three-eighths pole, was under encouragement turning for home three wide, made no headway. DAN AND SHEILA brushed with ALL THAT after getting carried inward at the start, was urged along in the two path, failed to reach a contending position. ALL THAT drifted inward after losing his footing at the start, making some contact with the nearest opponent was in the three path contesting the pace as the widest of a threesome for six furlongs before giving way. GHOST HUNTER clipped the heels of the runner up after the start, was in three path at the three-eighths pole, tired.
