Footnotes

POTOSI'S SILVER came away with no apparent mishap, wandered momentarily into the two path before settling along the inside route for the run around bend, tracked the front runners, under the mildest of coaxing to maintain interest, was kept on hold coming to the quarter pole, forced to await suitable options, found room to maneuver and got angled slightly to the outside for the commencement of the stretch, split rivals deep into the furlong grounds en route to taking charge, accelerated to the front and drew off, completing the final stages under a vigorous hand ride. SKY CREW contested the lead from the outside, proved no match for the winner in the final furlong, held on well to the end to secure second. BIDDY MARTIN saved ground, launched a rally that narrowly failed to procure the place. FOXBEAU took her initial step sharply inward, was yanked back with pressure on the opposite side almost immediately to get put back on a truer course, disputed the pace from the inside, came under heavy pressure while travelling through the furlong grounds, yielded a short distance past the eighth pole, weakened enough thereafter to have to settle for the final major slice of the pot. LAS OLAS AZUR three to four wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch after having put to a drive a sixteenth up the road, lacked the needed response. MACAROON bumped lightly with LEMON POINT as the field was sent on its way, raced from off the inside, mostly two wide on the turn, was in the five path by the top of the lane, tired. LEMON POINT was bumped lightly at the start, chased a pair of front runners three wide on the turn and gave way. EARTH TO MATILDA raced along the outside and was outrun.
