MADDIE MAY raced close up early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, could not get by the winner and continued on to earn the place award. BOUNDANDDETERMINED contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. BELONGS TO MONY was outrun early, raced three wide and lacked a rally. LOVELY AMANDA contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. ALY BAGHDAD chased the pace and tired after a half mile. MICH'S PITCH had no response when roused. SPEEDY'S DAY chased inside and was finished early.
