Footnotes

ALCHEMIST raced between rivals early, was steadied in traffic in upper stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and was up on the line. BUCK MOUNTAIN raced close up along the inside, angled out in upper stretch and dug in gamely to the wire. LITERACY was steadied after the start, was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. PERFECT ENERGY chased the pace from the outside, gained a short lead in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. EXCHANGE BAY raced in hand while three wide and lacked a rally. MA FEMME quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace and tired in the final furlong. INDY FIVE HUNDRED was rated along inside, was blocked along the inside in the stretch, altered course in deep stretch and lacked a rally. CLARKSBURG QUEEN was outrun early, came wide for the drive and had no rally. KURLICUE (IRE) stumbled at the start, chased the pace while between rivals and tired.
