Footnotes

ON THE CATWALK argued the pace from the outside, responded when roused in upper stretch and drew clear under a drive. LISA THE GREAT was outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn and finished well outside to get the place prize. SING TO THE SKY raced close up outside, put in a three wide run approaching the stretch, could not stay with the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished for the place. POLKADOT was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and rallied outside. SNITCH was outrun early, raced inside and was going well late inside. KEEN LASSIE was outrun early, raced inside, angled out in the stretch and lacked a rally. HAPID RALO chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. MY NINA ROSE raced wide throughout and tired. GOLDEN ACCOLADE (GB) had no rally. MORNING SKY was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. ACTSTATIC raced close up early while between rivals and tired. BAYMONT was outrun along the inside.
