MEADOW BREEZE broke running, contested the pace from the outside, dug in determinedly while drifting out in deep stretch, came again gamely and got the nod in a tight finish. FEATHERBED was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside, dug in resolutely while between rivals in the drive and was on even terms for the place at the finish. OCTAVE was urged along inside, rallied into the stretch and dug in on the rail in the drive. CASH'S GIRL was hustled along between rivals and had no response when roused. MAGICAL RIDE raced in hand outside, was three wide on the turn, had no response when roused and tired in the stretch. ETERNAL GRACE broke awkwardly, was outrun early, raced four wide on the turn and drifted out in the stretch.
