SODA POP KID pressed the pace from outside, surged to the front leaving the sixteenth pole and prevailed under steady urging. PRECIOUS PACKAGE was reserved for nearly a half while saving ground, swung four wide at the quarter pole and closed steadily but could not get up. RICHMOND set the pace into deep stretch and yielded late. THE TRUFFLE MAN stalked three wide for a half and lacked a strong closing bid. ALL THE BASES rushed up after breaking slowly, was under a firm hold along the rail for a half and lacked a late response. NO QUESTIONS failed to mount a serious rally.
