**Footnotes**

FENWAY FAITHFUL raced up close along the inside, rallied between horses on the turn, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the late stages. MINESWEPT was unhurried early, rallied four wide on the turn and closed steadily but could not get up. MINE OVER MATTER set the pace on the rail into midstretch and weakened. THUNDER CHIEF raced all back for a half, circled four wide and rallied belatedly. BACKCOUNTRY BOY chased three wide leaving the turn and finished evenly. MIDNIGHT BILLY raced in midpack between horses while three wide into upper stretch and lacked a late response. MOST HAPPY FELLA failed to mount a serious rally. LEATHERHEAD never reached contention. NEVER GIVE UP pressed the pace to the turn and gave way. FOURSEVENTEEN raced just off the pace along the rail and faded on the turn. BRIDGE TO NOWHERE checked at the start and was never close thereafter.
