BOOTS AHEAD took up the role of stalker before reaching the backstretch, sat under a firm hold, positioned just off the pacesetter's hind quarters, ranged up to apply more pressure leaving the half mile pole, turned for home on nearly even terms and got set down, fought his way to the front during the ensuing furlong, edged away, kept busy to the end. FOLLOWMYFOOTSTEPS quickly established control, cut the pace, rated along the inside until the quarter pole, entered the stretch holding only a slim advantage, yielded reluctantly during the run through the furlong grounds, held well enough to secure the place. RADICAL SABBATICAL saved ground until the quarter pole, displayed good late energy to grab the show award. PERFECT FOOTPRINT three wide until the seven-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. BEAU CHOIX chased from the outside and had no rally. VOODOO SWINGE off to a sluggish beginning, was always outrun. ASPHALT was through after completing three-quarters.
