ASSOCIATE the last to pop out of the starting gate, advanced willingly on his own power to take up a forward position, was let out a notch and overhauled the early leader from the two path with a quick move, edging away to a clear advantage, drew out to a commanding lead when asked for some run from the head of the stretch to the eighth pole, cruised to the wire thereafter placed to a very confident and mild hand ride. ORSONIAN established command soon after the start, showed the way from the three path, got displaced by the top one early during the run around the bend, unable to keep pace with that opponent, regained some of the lost ground under heavy encouragement from midpoint, lost contact for a second time when the winner was let out, easily held off the others for the place. CHAIRMAN NOW out hustled leaving the starting gate, raced three wide and bested the rest. ARNELL raced along the outside and proved no match for the top threesome. UPPER AFLEET three wide on the turn, was no factor. DEPARTURES four wide departing the backstretch, laded after going a half. QUICK RECOVERY took the inside route on the turn, wilted. OUT OF YOUR MIND well off the inside, displayed brief foot.
