DANCE CARD overhauled the early leader and established control before reaching the half mile pole, cruised along on an open lead from the two path before starting to wander outward during the later stages of the run around the bend, was slightly more than three wide by the head of the stretch, lengthened away while making her way from upper to midstretch, continuing to drift outward, had the pilot see no danger in sight with an eighth to go and was given the green light by him to remain on a course towards the grandstand apron, crossing the wire the same way she began the stretch run, handily. FINAL ESCROW tucked briefly along the inside down the backstretch, was in the two path and under some encouragement arriving at the half mile pole, was clearly overmatched by the winner, but rallied well enough to procure the place. LADY COHIBA bobbed at the start, raced from off the inside, swung four wide into the stretch and picked up the pieces to be along the show. MORROW COVE chased the winner around the turn and folded. PROUD PEARL the early leader while taking the inside route, was under a drive by the half mile pole, faltered. SEA ISLAND three wide departing the backstretch, was through after going six furlongs.
