Footnotes

AMERICAN BUFFALO three wide nearing the half mile pole, looped around a tiring LOGICAL ONE to take over as the chief challenger of CONCORDE EXPRESS, kept the pressure on that rival from the two path during the run around the bend, got set down spinning into the stretch, shook free of that foe but felt another pair soon afterwards, held on stubbornly to the wire to prove best. TAPITDAR rode the rail, got angled three wide leaving the five-sixteenths pole, rallied willingly but got denied. VEE'S ACCOLADE took the inside route for nearly three-quarters, advanced towards the front runners after turning for home, split rivals approaching the eighth pole, altered course outward a sixteenth later, continued onward with good energy en route for the show award. LAKE NONA three wide to four wide on the turn, tired steadily after going three-quarters. POWERFUL INSTINCT raced along the outside and mustered up

a mild response to improve position. CONCORDE EXPRESS broke on top, was down along the rail with the lead leaving the elbow chute, argued to maintain it with two different rivals for the opening six furlongs, tired after entering the stretch. UNGUIDED MISSILE four wide at the end of the backstretch, lacked the needed response. WHY BROADWAY guided over to the rail at the half mile pole, was no factor. LOGICAL ORDER disputed the pace from the outside for just a half before retreating. SMART FARDA was driven three wide into the stretch to no avail. PAVLOV'S DOG three wide departing the backstretch, tired. JUST A MINUTE came away a bit awkwardly at the start, raced from near the two path on the turn, left the midway point under a drive, folded.
