Footnotes

KHARAFa just off the pace, ranged up three wide at the seven-sixteenths accompanied outside by COUNTKNICKERBOCKER in the four path, seized a slight lead at the three-eighths pole as a quartet stacked up across the track, vied with that trio until shaking them off at the top of the lane, edged away with a furlong remaining, saw that margin cut into some late while kept to task to prevail driving. SLEEPY FREUD urged lightly along midpack while saving ground, was fully engaged by the rider at the five-sixteenths, kicked home with good energy late on in the final sixteenth to safely procure the place honors. WESTERN TRYST three wide towards the rear, progressed steadily through the turn coming under urging at the three-eighths pole, swung five wide for home losing some momentum, offered up good late foot to procure the show. MR ALGEBRA broke in at the start bumping and closing off ANAPHYLAXIS squeezing that rival in tandem with RIZZI'S COMET who broke outwards, vied from the two path accompanied inside early on before being engaged by a trio midway on the turn, lost the lead at the three-eighths by a slim margin, cut the corner into the stretch roused, offered up a mild rally down inside for the last major share. COUNTKNICKERBOCKER just off the pace ranged up four wide in tandem with KHARAFa at the seven-sixteenths, was stacked four wide and urged along at the three-eighths pole, spun four wide for home, remained in contention until the final eighth when out kicked in the late stages. SAM HILLIC squeezed slightly at the break when RIZZI'S COMET broke outwards and MR ALGEBRA came in, settled midpack three wide through the turn, was urged at the three-eighths pole, spun four wide in upper stretch and weakened. ANAPHYLAXIS bumped and squeezed out at the start from pressure coming on both side, raced two to three wide towards the rear, got asked at the midway point on the turn and offered no response. JETER saved ground towards the rear and was never involved. RIZZI'S COMET broke out at the start putting the squeeze on SAM HILLIC and ANAPHYLAXIS in tandem with MR ALGEBRA, vied inside urged along, remained in prominence until straightening for home and gave way.
