Footnotes

CIRO was rated along inside, picked it up quickly along the inside on the second turn, angled out and swung six wide into the stretch, accelerated when set down for the drive and drew clear under a vigorous hand ride. WHATA BRAINSTORM was taken back along the inside, angled out and circled five wide on the second turn, reached the front between calls in upper stretch and stayed on gamely but was no match for the winner. LODGE HILL raced close up inside while in hand, angled to the outside in midstretch and stayed on well to the finish. POLISH MINER was outrun early on, raced wide on the second turn and had no rally. AVOWED argued the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. CARDINAL VERSE set the pace under constant pressure and gave way in the stretch. ROB'S SPIRIT raced with the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. GRAND FINALE (IRE) was hustled along outside and tired. SAILING (GB) raced between rivals, tired badly and was eased in the stretch. DAWN OF THE CONDOR chased outside, raced wide throughout, stopped on the second turn and was eased in the stretch.
