DISRUPT was in hand early on, advanced inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch, finished determinedly and was along late from the outside, driving. LARGER THAN LIFE stumbled after the start but quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand and dug in gamely along the inside in the stretch. O'CAT was unhurried early on, rallied outside on the turn and was outfinished. DYNARHYTHM raced close up while wide and had no response when roused. DATTT WAY was outrun early and had no rally. LA PIQUE DAME was steadied after the start, put in a run along the inside on the turn and tired in the stretch. GRACIOUS LADY tired after a half mile. JEWEL'S DREAM had no response when roused. MAGPIE chased the pace along the inside and was finished early. R RAGGEDY ANN tired after showing brief speed and lost contact with the field.
