BLUEGRASS CAT was hustled up along the inside, set the pace on the rail, drew clear when roused and was kept busy to the wire. ROCKANDAHARDPLACE was bumped at the start, raced close up early, rallied inside nearing the stretch, angled out, could not get to the winner and dug in to hold the place. A. J. AWESOME ducked in at the start, was outrun early, rallied wide on the turn, was carried wider into the stretch and finished well while racing greenly. SAINT DAIMON broke awkwardly, raced greenly, drifted out entering the stretch and drifted in in the drive. BARBICAN raced inside and had no response when roused. AWESOME WAY was outrun early, came wide for the drive and had no rally. TUSCAN PRINCE was bumped at the start, chased the pace while three wide and tired while racing greenly in the stretch. GREELEY'S LEGACY was bothered at the start, was steadied after the start, raced wide and tired. PACIFIC STORM stumbled after the start, argued the pace from the outside and tired after a half mile.
