Non-winners of a sweepstakes on the turf in 2008 allowed 2lbs. Three Races, 4 lbs.(Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances). WISHFUL TOMCAT lunged at the start, was placed under a good hold, content to bring up the rear during the opening stages, gradually advanced into contention while taking the inside route, had his momentum stalled when forced to await racing room nearing the furlong grounds, willingly split rivals when clearance appeared at the sixteenth pole, surged past the leaders to take charge then dug in gamely to turn back BIG TRUCK in the late stages. BIG TRUCK raced along the outside, was steadied in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole when RUSSIAN SAGE ducked inward, angled outward at the eighth pole, quickly settled into stride, finished with good energy to narrowly miss. BE BULLISH was allowed to drop back a bit early during the run down the backstretch, choosing not to get involved in an early three-way speed fight, contently stalked the leaders from the three path during the run around the bend, was asked for a response turning for home, worked his way to a brief lead by midstretch, then was outfinished by the top pair during the final sixteenth. RUSSIAN SAGE pressed the pace from the outside, ducked inward a bit in upper stretch, lacked the necessary stretch response. MEGAPIXEL vied for the lead along the inside until the furlong marker, weakened thereafter. MISSINGLISALEWIS was no factor. DOC N ROLL forwardly placed while wide for a half, gave way.
