Footnotes

GROUND FROST took control soon after leaving the starting gate, was placed under a good hold while cutting the fractions during the initial three-quarters, was asked for a bit more as the field headed for home, extended his advantage by midstretch, then turned back ALLEGRE during the final furlong while being kept busy to the wire. ALLEGRE reserved along the inside, continued to take the inside route until being swung outward midway on the second turn, was fanned four wide into the lane, came home with good energy during the stretch drive. PROPENSITY off slowly, was outrun for six furlongs, displayed a good finish down the center of the course. D' WILDCARD finished willingly. KAPTAIN saved ground throughout, needed more to get the job done. CERTIFIABLY ROYAL caught three wide on the opening bend, raced within striking distance for a half, advanced to challenge for the lead after entering the far turn, while continuing to race well off the inside, had nothing left to sustain the bid during the final furlong. QUITE APT lacked the necessary stretch response. INTERFERENCE underwent a three wide journey and tired. SOL A PINO raced three wide on both turns and gave way after six furlongs. SKYWIRE pursued the pacesetter from the outside for three quarters before folding. COZZENE'S DESTINY tired badly.
