SILVER HORSESHOE vied for the lead from the outside with the rider keeping something in reserve, shook free in upper stretch after being put to a hand ride, drew off a commanding advantage leaving the furlong ground, appeared choppy-gaited nearing the sixteenth pole, but maintained a safe winning margin under careful handling, then was vanned off after crossing the finish line. KINKORA off the inside, was coaxed into a good striking position by the time she reached the quarter pole, took off in earnest after turning for home, proceeded to deceptively gain ground on the top during the last sixteenth. HONEST GOLD was slow to settle into stride, began to pick up the pace nearing the end of run down the backstretch, accelerated to rejoin the pack under mild encouragement during the run around the bend, swung three wide into the lane to continue the rally, steadily slightly while caught in a bit tight between rivals at the three-sixteenths pole, briefly losing some momentum, got clear of that predicament and altered course over to the inside, displayed a good rally from that point en route for the show. STARLIGHT TIARA chased three wide and tired after going a half. CAUTIONARY TALE saved ground until the quarter pole. QUIPPERY strung out four wide at the seven-sixteenths pole, gave way. LADY CHESTERFIELD hit the left side of the gate at the start, was forwardly placed for a half and folded. A TRIPP ROYALE contested the pace from the inside for a half and faltered.
