Footnotes

COOKRAM ROCK forwardly placed while undergoing a wide journey, bided time until nearing the head of the stretch, responded well once given his cue, narrowed in on the leader during the run through the furlong grounds, relentlessly continued the pursuit, reached even terms in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, grabbed a slim advantage by deep stretch and dug in stubbornly to preserve the decision. CITY SNEAKERS grabbed the lead soon after the start, set the pace along the inside with the rider applying rating tactics until the quarter pole, was put to encouragement turning for home, felt the top one's presence soon after leaving the eighth pole, offered good resistance, relinquished the lead, battled on gamely, but had to settle for being clearly second best. MIDNIGHT BILLY had a four wide journey and held well to earn show honors. SMART ENUF three wide around the opening bend, moved up to stalk the leader, by now a bit closer to the inside, shortly after entering the backstretch, accompanied the pacesetter from there under a good hold until nearing the head of the stretch, failed to keep pace during the stretch drive, steadily weakening during the last eighth. TYPHOON TYCOON raced along the outside and lacked the necessary stretch response. SILENCED saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. MR. HOOKER was no factor. PRINCE DUBAI took the inside route, attempted a bid still hugging the rail after turning for home, was forced to be steadied when caught in tight quarters in upper stretch, got back going and completed the race from there under a light drive. VOSE THE HOST saved ground until the quarter pole. MONASTIR took the overland route around the far turn to no avail.
