WISHINGONASTAR assumed a forward position soon after the start, was lightly coaxed along to stay within striking distance of the early front runners, ducked into the two path when MORALITY drifted out slightly midway on the turn, got asked for run, struck the front in the vicinity of the eighth pole, kicked clear, then completed the final sixteenth under confident handling. MORALITY vied for command from off the inside, shook free under his own power while drifting briefly into the three path near the three-eighths pole, was successfully maneuvered closer to the rail in time for the stretch drive, felt the top one's presence by the quarter pole and was let out, offered some resistance before relinquishing, continued onward to be second best. GREEN BANANAS was put to some encouragement starting with the run down the backstretch, cut the corner into the lane and was along for the show. MR. HADIF three wide, sparred with the runner up for nearly a half before backing away. UNBRIDLED DANGER chased the early pace dispute and came up empty. STEALTH MISSILE three wide departing the backstretch, gave way. EX PAT failed to menace. MARINA MARKET raced along the outside, drifted six wide into the stretch while tiring, was eased coming to the furlong marker.
