Footnotes

COMMON OBJECTIVE, away in good order and with the pace along the rail, took over from the inside nearing the stretch, drew clear when roused in upper stretch and remained clear under a vigorous hand ride. BROOMESSE chased inside, came wide for the drive and finished gamely from the outside. PENTELIS, never far back while three wide, worked her way through traffic in the stretch and finished gamely inside. PENTATONIC, outrun early, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and finished well. BIOGIO'S BABY chased the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. MISS THERMAL TECH, away awkwardly and steadied on the backstretch, put in a five wide run approaching the stretch but could not sustain that bid. WINLOC'S GLORIOUS contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. TIMELESS TEMPO chased the pace and tired. NATALARIA raced wide and had no rally. NIKKI JEAN chased four wide and tired. MICH'S PITCH tired after an inside trip. SWEET E. L. A. raced five wide and tired.
