Footnotes

UNACCOUNTABLE pressed the pace from outside for most of the way, surged to the front in midstretch, battled heads apart into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. BIG AL set the pace into midstretch, dug in leaving the eighth pole, battled back in deep stretch and lost the bob. NEW YORK HOLIDAY was reserved for a half, rallied three wide on the turn and finished willingly to gain a share. INDYMININE checked at the start, was outrun for a half, rapidly gained along the rail leaving the turn and closed late along the inside. BLAZING DYNAMO raced up close between for a half, dropped back between horses on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. VICTORY ASSURED raced in hand along the rail for six furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. MASTEROFTHEHOUSE raced well in hand in the two path for a half, was within striking distance on the turn and faded in upper stretch. ECRU EGRET was a bit rank in the early stages and failed to threaten while four wide. BURNS UP THE TRACK checked at the start and was never close thereafter. MAY DAY NOW raced in midpack and gave way on the turn.
