Footnotes

APTPHILLY broke well and set the pace just off the inside while under reserve, was lightly urged midway on the turn and responded widening her lead, was fully roused coming to the eighth pole and drew clear while being kept busy to the end. GRACE ALLEY saved ground down the backside and throughout the turn, came under a prolonged drive early on in the turn and commenced to rally while angling out one path at the head of the stretch, held well for second while never threatening the top one. ST. LUCY tracked the leader three wide throughout, came under a prolonged drive and offered up a mild rally to secure the show spot. MY NAN NELL (IRE) in a bit tight between rivals early on, was taken back, roused midway on the turn and rallied belatedly for the last major share past tired rivals. CAP THE THUNDER vied between rivals into the turn, got asked for run at the quarter pole and tired. SCHILLERETTE lightly brushed the gate on her left side, and reacted to the rider's correction by bearing outward after the start, took the overland route throughout the turn and was outrun. PROVEN RIGHT in contention for the first half, offered little and was eased at the top of the lane.
