Footnotes

RUNNING TAP argued for the lead while taking the inside route, took charge and shook free late on the turn, sat on hold until entering the stretch, drew off to a commanding lead by midstretch, saw the margin dwindle down, just held on to finish on even terms with STUD MUFFIN. STUD MUFFIN took the overland route, closed in relentlessly during the stretch run to finish in a dead head with RUNNING TAP. SHOW TRIAL outrun for the opening half, was urged from the five path into the stretch, rallied well enough to be along for the show. JUST HOLD ON broke inward, crowding a couple of opponents at the start and bumping with the nearest one as well, went to to take up a forward position, flip flopped paths after SAINTS ALIVE crossed over to be two wide just reaching the turn, kept up the pressure three wide for most of the way around the bend before backing away. EZZY came outward twice in the early stages of the race, both times initiating contact with PAVORATTI'S SOUL, was four wide for a good portion of the run around the bend, got put to a prolonged drive but could make no headway on the front runners. MR. VANTASTIC got squeezed back after being bumped soundly at the break, quickly tucked along the rail, was set down by midway on the turn, failed to have an impact on the outcome. STORMY SUCCESS off the inside, altered course to the inside in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, had no kick. EON broke on top, was yanked on the reins and allow to ease back, left the backstretch four wide, was already under encouragement leaving the three-eighths pole, folded. I AIN'T NO SAINT four wide at the half mile pole, was through after going a half. PAVORATTI'S SOUL sandwiched at the start, stayed within range for a half before faltering. SAINTS ALIVE vied for the lead from the two path, got overtaken past the three-eighths pole, retreated to the back of the pack then was eased.
