INDEPENDENCE WAR contently tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, availed of the opportunity by making a quick rail move at the quarter pole to grab the lead, lengthened away to a sizeable advantage during the ensuing furlong, began to shorten stride noticeably in the late stages, but had plenty of time to reach the finish line safely. IRON LOU chased from the outside, ducked inward in upper stretch and finished well to procure the place. B G SUAVECITO raced three wide on the turn and held well en route for show honors. DARRIN'S DILEMMA the last to pop out of the starting gate, rushed up to grab the front under light encouragement, felt some pressure late on the turn, was powerless to match the top one's quick turn of speed heading into the stretch, weakened steadily during the last eighth. ZIP QUIK three wide entering the turn was five wide departing it, lacked the necessary stretch response. POPPA'S PICK pressed the issue from the two path during the run around the bend and gave way. DIVINE CHILD off the inside, was no factor. NO QUESTIONS outrun for a half, swung five wide into the lane, appeared to take a bad step in upper stretch, was pulled up and subsequently vanned off.
