WAVE THEORY reserved in the two path for the opening three-quarters, entered the stretch four wide and under a drive, kicked clear of the front runners to emerge with the lead with an eighth to go, had the runner draw abreast shortly afterwards, dug in with good determination to stave that opponent off. INDUSTRIAL POLICY steadied right after the start as LADY OF GOLD was working her way towards the inside, was unhurried off the inside during the initial stages, picked up interest departing the backstretch, was under strong handling spinning five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and closed in with good energy, maintained the momentum past the eighth pole, engaged in one on one battle with the winner, tried hard to go by but was denied by a stubborn foe. ROCK ON BABY rode the rail, slipped into the two path near the five-sixteenths marker, entered the stretch and was asked for a response, rallied willingly to secure the show, although never posing a threat to either of the first two finishers. LADY OF GOLD sat forwardly placed three wide on both turns, got put to some encouragement to keep pace on the second one, launched a run from upper to midstretch to loom boldly by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, couldn't sustain it and backed away. EDDY GOURMET tracked the leader from the pocket and came up empty. INDIAN STARLIGHT accompanied the pacesetter parked to that rival's outside and gave way. WICKAPECKO the first to be loaded into the starting gate, without rider aboard while doing so, came out with no apparent mishap, quickly established control and was placed along the inside route, showed the way rated for nearly six furlongs, felt a build up in the pressure approaching the quarter pole and was let out, yielded and faltered. CAXAMBAS PASS three wide on each bend, tired. LISVERNANE displayed brief foot racing between rivals in the early going, dropped back after appearing to have the saddle slip, and was eased over time.
