BAFFLE ME assumed the role of primary pursuer shortly after the start, prompted the leader from the two path under a firm hold by the rider until the top of the lane, was given her cue and responded positively, ground her way to a slight advantage during the ensuing furlong, extended the margin the rest of the way to the finish line, being under a brisk hand ride as she crossed it. MOMENT IN DIXIE got away a half beat slowly, got put to some light hand urging and settled into the middle of the field, rode the rail until a couple of jumps before reaching the quarter pole, got asked for run angling outward for the commencement of the drive home, failed to keep up with the winner, but mustered up enough of a response to procure the place. FREE AS A BIRD was rated along the inside while showing the way, got set down turning for home with the winner directly alongside, offered some resistance before relinquishing, weakened steadily in the final furlong. CORSAGE two wide and under some hand urging, raced between rivals for most of the way around the bend, swung three wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. MY JOPIA broke slightly to the outside, yet on top, chased three wide on the turn and gave way. SOUNDS OF THE CITY off the inside, got put to a drive near the three-eighths pole, came four wide into the stretch, had no offering.
