Footnotes

RAVALO unhurried in the opening stages, picked up interest late on the bend, had already been put to strong encouragement turning for home, got fanned outward until four to five wide by the three-sixteenths pole, cut into the gap, hitching up to the runner up with an eighth to go, took over and edged clear. HANNIBAL LECTER kept watch on a three way tussle during the run around the bend, racing along the inside, was taken hold of prior to cutting the corner into the stretch, momentarily lacking optimal racing clearance to launch a bid, had the former pacesetter drift outward during the opening phases of the drive home to provide the needed room, got set down and arrived at the furlong marker as the new leader, got engaged in a battle with the winner shortly afterwards, relinquished while under a strong drive, held on well though for the place. EASTWOOD pressed the issue from between rivals from the top of the turn until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, weakened steadily thereafter. DON TITO gently squeezed after bumping with STAGE STREET at the start, raced along outside and failed to menace. STAGE STREET came inward, bumping with DON TITO, went on to grab a narrow advantage, carved the pace while racing towards the inside, came under pressure from both sides just before spinning into the stretch, drifted outward a bit in upper stretch, yielded in short order and tired. READYTODEFER three wide on the turn, was through after going a half.
