DEEP DIVE, set the pace along the inside, drew clear when asked for run, was ridden out to the wire. WILD BRAIN prompted the pace from the outside and stayed gamely. PRIVATELY HELD, rated outside, finished gamely after a three wide trip. RIVETER, rated inside, was roused on the second turn and finished well. SKY APPROVAL, taken back early, saved ground into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch but had no solid finishing kick. RIVERSHADE had no rally after an inside trip. TRIPLE TWENTY, NEON NIGHT and MISTER JIGGS were outrun. HONG KONG HENRY chased the pace then stopped badly and was eased in the stretch.
