DISTINCTUAL, close up inside, advanced on the rail approaching the stretch, swung three wide turning for home and drew clear under a drive. COSETTE came out at the start, crowding GOLD 'N SUGAR into DALE'S BARGAIN and causing that rival to bump SWEET REBECCA N, then was hustled out to a clear lead, set the pace and continued on gamely on the rail. GOLD 'N SUGAR, bumped at the start, chased the pace and tired in the final furlong. SWEET REBECCA N, roughed up between rivals at the start, raced four wide and was going well late. JOVIAL CHARADE, rated outside, was steadied between rivals nearing the stretch, came wide for the drive and lacked a solid finishing kick. SIDEROWF raced inside and had no rally. DALE'S BARGAIN, bumped at the start, raced four wide and tired. BURNA WHO tired. CASERTA, bumped at the start, tired.
