MISS HELLIE was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, finished gamely outside and was along in time, driving. D'OHANA (ARG) raced close up outside, rallied three wide on the second turn and dug in gamely to the wire. NOISETTE prompted the pace from the outside and dug in gamely on the rail in the stretch. AZTEC PEARL was rated along early, raced inside and finished gamely. BEYOND THE WAVES was rated along early, was shuffled back on the second turn, was steadied in upper stretch and finished gamely while in traffic. RAINBOWS FOR ALL (IRE) was rated along early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a solid finishing kick. PRIMA CREATURA (IRE) was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. MAGNIFICENT VAL raced close up inside, saved ground and tired. SONATA COSMOS set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
