DOC'S DOLL argued the pace along the inside while in hand, drew clear when roused and remained clear under a drive. DOUBLE HALO raced close up inside early, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside. HARD AS NAILS set the pace while between rivals and faded in the stretch. BIOGIO'S BEAUTY raced with the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. STAKE raced with the pace while between rivals and had no response when roused. SWEET SCREAMER was outrun early, raced wide and had no rally. BURST OF DAWN raced with the pace while four wide and tired in the stretch. MY VENGEANCE raced inside and had no rally.
