WHO WHAT WIN raced close up along the inside, came wide into the stretch, responded to steady pressure and was up in time from the outside. FRENCH TRANSITION was bumped at the start, raced close up while between rivals and finished well on the rail. BUILDING NEW ERA raced close up outside, put in a four wide run on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. LORD LANGFUHR was outrun early, raced inside and lacked a rally. RACELAND was bumped at the start, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. MORNING PERKS chased the pace from the outside and tired.
