GHOSTZAPPER was outrun early, raced outside, put in a quick four wide move nearing the stretch, reached the front leaving the eighth pole and drew away under a drive. AGGADAN raced close up outside, rallied three wide entering the stretch, gained a short lead at the eighth pole, had no answer for the winner and dug in to hold the place. POSSE raced within striking distance along the inside, split rivals approaching the stretch, lacked room while in traffic in upper stretch and altered course to the outside. GYGISTAR stumbled at the start, raced close up inside and was bumped along the rail in the stretch. MY COUSIN MATT pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. VOODOO was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and was bumped while tiring in the stretch. HIGHWAY PROSPECTOR was outrun early, raced three wide and had no response when roused. PAPUA dropped back early, raced between rivals and tired in the stretch. AJEDREZ (ARG) was hustled outside, chased the pace for a half mile and tired. PEEPING TOM was outrun early, raced inside and tired.
