BLACK SEVENTEEN urged leaving the starting gate, was placed under a good hold soon afterwards, sat perched outside the speed fight while racing five wide, advanced into contention after entering the turn, began to rally in earnest when put to stiff handling turning for home, reached even terms with FABULOUS STRIKE a few strides past the eighth pole, then finished with determination to prevail at the finish line. FABULOUS STRIKE away to an alert start, vied for the lead with a pair of rivals while racing off the inside, briefly shook free after entering the stretch, met a fresh challenger leaving the furlong grounds, dug down gamely to the end. KODIAK KOWBOY unhurried for three furlongs, commenced his rally after being roused midway on the turn, finished willingly along the outside to grab the show. ROCKERFELLER wide throughout, failed to menace. J BE K hustled from the starting gate, fought for the lead between rivals for a half, travelling in the three path, and gave way. LUCKY ISLAND (ARG) saved ground throughout to no avail. FIRST DEFENCE fought for the lead while racing four wide, began to steadily tire after going three furlongs.
