**Footnotes**

PIERROT LUNAIRE sat reserved while saving ground until the fourth and final turn, was angled outward before reaching the midway point on it, kept going wider and wider, under some encouragement until turning for home four wide, quickened approaching the final hurdle under a drive and was first to go over, had the runner up draw alongside soon afterwards, dug in gamely as the pair traded bobs in the late stages to prevail. SPY IN THE SKY raced three wide around all four turns, fanned extremely wide for the stretch drive, settling into about the six path (the widest of all), kicked in with good energy once given his cue, hooked up a spirited tussle with the winner during the final eighth, battled hard and with good determination but was ultimately denied at the end. CHARMINSTER (IRE) strung out three wide on the opening bend, remained off the inside throughout, was cued up approaching the stretch for the final time and finished willingly to secure the show award. LEFT UNSAID patiently tracked the pacesetter while racing along the inside, picked up the pace upon arriving on the fourth turn, made a run trying to establish command heading for the top of the lane, neared the last jump still prominently placed only to flatten out. HISTORY BOY raced along the outside and was no factor. DIVINE FORTUNE saved ground until the last turn, had no rally. DUC DE SAVOIE rated from off the inside on an uncontested lead, gave way once challenged in earnest. TAX RULING loosely stalked the leader, was put to a drive after departing the backstretch the second time, tired. THE JIGSAW MAN (IRE) chased from the outside and folded. ALL TOGETHER bobbed over the first hurdle, trailed throughout and left the course before attempting the final jump.
