Footnotes

CENTRIQUE rated tracking from just off the inside midpack, cut the corner into the lane steadily progressing on the front under her own power, got the lightest of hand urging nearing the eighth pole, took over at that station, went clear under very light hand urging to prevail comfortably. BID A MOON two to three wide towards the rear, swung five wide for home under a drive, moved into contention a furlong out, offered up a good kick in the late stages to just garner the place on the wire while never threatening the top. WORLD PREMIER three wide in midpack, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, shifted out to the four path at the five-sixteenths commencing a bid on the front, swung four wide for home, had the rider spot CENTRIQUE inside moving to vie for command, shifted his charge in to look that foe in the eye, got overhauled after having a brief lead, kept on through the latter portion of the stretch drive getting out kicked late on and forced to settle for the show honors. DONNATALE chased inside towards the rear, came under encouragement at the quarter pole, angled out for a clear lane as a wall of rivals stacked up in front four abreast at the eighth pole, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. LOBSHOT prompted the pace while two to three wide, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, remained a forward factor until nearing the furlong grounds before weakening in the late stages. OUR MARY ELIZABETH three wide just off the pace, came under coaxing at the midway point on the turn, remained prominent until nearing the final furlong and tired. MESS IN A DRESS towards the rear chasing two to three wide, got set down at the three-eighths pole, swung six wide in upper stretch and never threatened. UNION BOSS hustled from the gate, set the pace while prompted from the two path, got let out at the five-sixteenths, was overhauled at the three-sixteenths and faltered.
