Footnotes

CANDY FEAT patiently tracked the team of front runners while taking the inside route, picked up interest and angled three wide coming into the stretch, gained ground readily making his way through the furlong grounds, continued onward to take over in the last few strides. NIGHT SITE bobbed inward bumping with MASERATI as a result, moved up into a forward position and raced heads apart from the the outside with FACT, was grabbed hold and given a respite from midway down the backstretch until its end, got let out a notch and drew on even terms once more in time for the run around the far turn, was the second of the two front runners to commit to some encouragement, doing so a slight distance past the quarter pole, edged away from FACT but felt the presence of the top one soon afterwards, resisted well before finally getting collared in deep stretch. FACT sparred on nearly terms with the runner up for much of the initial half, had that foe back off a bit midway down the backstretch and sit parked just off the hind quarters, but was again back to sparring on even terms by the far turn, got asked for some run leaving the five-sixteenths pole yet fell back a bit nonetheless, remained a prominent factor for another furlong and tired. MASERATI (BRZ) squeezed back after being bumped from both sides at the start, bobbed a couple of jumps later, lagged behind as the trailer in the early going, spun into the lane and kicked in with some belatedly energy. LURE OF THE SOUTH three wide at the three-eighths pole, had no rally. POPPLESTONE was no factor. CODE Z bumped at the start, was never involved. SEATTLE APPEAL chased from the outside from well off the front runners, needed some encouragement by the three-eighths pole, folded and was vanned off after the finish. GULF OF ADEN raced towards the inside and was never in contention.
