CHIEF GAGA away alertly, was allowed to settle just off the pace three wide under reserve, patiently waited keeping pace with the front under mostly his own power, got set down at the head of the lane, led briefly before being displaced at the eighth pole, fought back on inside to reclaim the front for good with a sixteenth to go, edged away under mostly hand urging to prevail in a determined effort. LASSO reserved tracking along the inside, shifted out to be four wide commencing a drive at the quarter pole, took a brief lead a furlong out, succumbed the front before completing another sixteenth, kept on to the wire just holding for the place while being outfinished in the late stages by the top one. IN SPEIGHT OFITALL three wide towards the rear, came under prolonged urging form the half mile pole, saved ground throughout, angled out for a clear path nearing the eighth pole, kicked home with late energy to secure the show honors. WALLY DID IT lunged at the start, settled two to three wide in midpack, came under a drive at the three-eighths pole, spun four wide for home offering up a mild kick for the last major share. AMBER COAST squeezed lightly at the start, raced three to four wide towards the rear, swung five wide in upper stretch, kicked home belatedly by tired foes. TRICKY SLAM just off the pace in the three path, came under urging midway on the turn, cornered five wide in upper stretch, remained in contention until the final eighth before weakening in the late stages. RUTHLESS ALLEY forwardly placed tracking the front under coaxing, got set down at the three-eighths pole, weakened after turning for home. FRANKY NAILS steadied when squeezed out at the start from pressure on both sides, settled four wide towards the rear, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths and offered no kick. MOONSHINE RIDGE hit the offside stall at the start, raced overland through the turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths and offered no response after swinging four wide for home. RELENTLESS ROAD broke in at the start, set the pace inside under coaxing, cut the corner into the stretch let out fully, remained in front until headed at the three sixteenths and gave way. TURINI towards the rear just off the inside, was pushed along from the five-sixteenths and was never involved.
