SPRINGCOURT was guided over to the rail before the initial fraction had been set, saved ground to the quarter pole, angled outward for the commencement of the drive home and was asked for a response, gave it and started to cut into the leader's margin, split rivals through a large opening in midstretch in the midst of her rally, continued onward, drifted out, leading the pilot to switch over to exclusively to a hand ride for encouragement, and light stick work near the right shoulder to keep from straying too far to the outside, wrested away the lead in the final stages to prove best. MR. STYLE vied for command with POLITICAL JUSTICE parked to the outside, continued along under those same conditions until nearing the five-sixteenths marker, shook off the much more energetically-handled previously-named nemesis, was almost a furlong down the road before getting called for run herself, responded positively, arriving at the eighth pole still in front by a healthy margin but with the eventual winner now having found her best stride, got reeled in the late stages and had to settle for the place. ST LIAMS HALO raced between rivals for a good portion of the way down the backstretch, was three wide entering the turn and four wide exiting it, got placed to a drive past the three-eighths pole, failed to come up with a solid response. CURVE BALL underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, had no rally. ALI'S WINNER off the inside, was taken over to the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner having already been put to a drive, came up empty. POLITICAL JUSTICE disputed the pace from the two path until the five-sixteenths pole, fell back despite getting roused, got eased.
