POINT TAKEN away alertly, was gradually guided over to the rail, argued for control with FRAZIL parked to the outside, needed strong handling by the midway point on the turn to remain on even terms, began to drift to the outside in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, drifted out even more dramatically after receiving some left handed stick work, wound up both carrying out then bumping solidly with the chief nemesis, forged on ahead to be the first to cross the finish line. FRAZIL hooked up in pace dispute early down the backstretch, kept pace with that rival, while under more confident handling during the majority of the run around the bend, had the fight spill over into the stretch, chiseled away at the lead racing through the furlong grounds and beyond, got bumped into hard by the errant unofficial winner in deep stretch after initially getting herded out a bit, displayed good courage to the end through it all. RAGING DAoust positioned three wide off the duel, was under solid encouragement by the five-sixteenths marker, made up ground steadily while proceeding down the stretch without ever posing a threat. SINORICE unhurried, commenced the stretch four wide, mustered up a mild rally while securing the last major check. MATT AND JESSE between rivals on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. INDY SCENT three wide at the head of the stretch, had no rally. METAURUS in a tight, got checked early down the backstretch, took the inside route, racing side by side with MATT AND JESSE for nearly three-quarters, was already driving cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty. ANAPHYLAXIS three wide departing the backstretch, was never involved. After a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run, as well as a claim of foul lodged by rider of FRAZIL against the rider of POINT TAKEN alleging interference in the stretch, the latter was disqualified from first and placed second for indeed causing interference.
