FLASHING TAMMANY, never far back while in hand, rallied wide on the turn, reached the front nearing the eighth pole then drew clear under a steady drive. WOULDND'T WE ALL quickly sprinted clear, set the pace while in hand then dug in gamely through the stretch. RISKY BUY raced wide and finished gamely from the outside. WATCH THE BIRD, hustled along outside and five wide on the turn, altered course to the inside approaching the stretch and finished with good courage on the rail. LIL'S LAD was put to the whip leaving the gate, was angled to the outside on the backstretch, raced closest to pacesetter WOULDND'T WE ALL for the opening half mile but came up empty despite being hard-ridden into the stretch.
