SPA CITY LOVER in reserve and well placed early just in behind a pace dispute, saved ground throughout the turn, spun three wide at the head of the stretch being lightly urged at the quarter, came under a more pronounced drive at the eighth pole and took over shortly thereafter inching clear under intermittent urging. SUPERIOR SARAH tracked the lead just off the inside while in hand, took over from a tired pacesetter at the quarter pole, asked for run at the three-sixteenths and responded readily staying in front until the final sixteenth before relinquishing to the aforementioned rival. WEDDING IN SORANO lightly urged at the half to close the gap, made steady progress on the front while three wide around the turn, angled out five wide at the top of the lane and then again slightly at the three sixteenths to avoid contact with OATKA IDAS ROSE, rallied gradually flattening out in the final sixteenth while well clear for the show. OATKA IDAS ROSE three to four wide throughout while up close to a pace dispute offered a mild response mostly staving off tired rivals for the last major share. FIDDLERS DIVA coaxed along to close ground at the nine-sixteenths, angled gradually out through the turn, swung five to six wide at the head of the stretch and offered no kick. KAFFIEND settled early towards the back, took the overland route in the turn never reaching contention. GAMBLING GERALDINE set the pace while in reserve along the inside, got overtaken at the quarter pole and faltered.
